

Parent-Student Covenant

“PowerLife Camp Rules”

1. Smoking, alcoholic beverages, drugs, are under no circumstances allowed.
2. Students are not allowed to go outside of the camp boundaries.
3. No one will be allowed any time in the sleeping quarters of the opposite sex.
4. Students are expected to respect all adults at all times and to understand that they have the final say without any argument.
5. All students are to be in attendance and on time for all meals, services, and group meetings.
6. No one is to be outside of his or her sleeping quarters after “lights out!”
7. Students are to respectfully treat the campus as well as the private property of others.
8. Only clothing that is in good taste and in accordance with Christian discretion should be worn. Only one-piece swimsuits are allowed for girls and swim trunks for boys. No Cut offs shorts allowed in the swimming area. Halter tops, strapless tops, cheer Shorts/soffee’s are **NOT Allowed At Anytime**. Boxer shorts exposed outside of clothing is **Not** allowed. Shorts are permitted as long as they are at least fingertip length or longer. **Shorts are Not allowed during the evening worship services.**
9. Electronic devices are not allowed i.e. no I-Pods, MP3 players, games etc. No Secular magazines will be allowed. Cell phones are to be turned off in all worship Services.
10. All students are expected to OBEY All RULES or they will be sent home at The parent’s expense.
11. **No touching of the opposite sex.** All couples are to be with other people or groups. No pairing off and hiding in private areas of the campus.

In order to have a safe and controlled camp, it is vitally important to have students along who are willing to abide by all the rules stated above. This camp is a rare experience in the life of your student and can truly make a major difference in the directions of their lives. However, this is not a place for a student that is not used to following directions and abiding by rules or is disrespectful of authorities such as counselors, to the degree that they become a risk for us. Therefore, it will be known to you and your student what our policy is, and that breaking any of the rules, they will get a fair and reasonable warning and conversation to help them to know the next offense will be a trip home with you, the parent coming to get them.

If there is anything that we should know about your student concerning tobacco, drugs, alcohol, etc, we trust that you will share these things with your leaders so that we can evaluate the nature of your students needs.
